Conference Announcement

The 5th Annual Conference of the Ghana Association of Agricultural Economists (GAAE) dubbed **GAAE 2022 Conference** will be held at the University of Energy and Natural Resources, Sunyani, from Wednesday 5th October to Saturday 8th October 2022.

Conference Preamble

The global population has been increasing rapidly over the years. The UN projected the world's population to keep growing, and estimates have put the world's total population at 9.8 billion by mid-2050. There is, therefore, the need to manage the scarce agricultural resources to meet current and future demands for food and fibre. While the means of boosting agricultural production are enormous, the question arising is what agricultural innovations are required to increase production of food and fibre for the increasing population. Further, in this era of digitisation, to what extent can digital agriculture address the challenges facing agri-food systems? Entrepreneurship, marketing and trade are critical elements for enhancing the performance of agri-food systems towards achieving food security and sustainable agricultural development. Focusing on these themes will contribute to achieving the following Sustainable Development Goals: 1 (no poverty), 2 (zero hunger), 8 (decent work and economic growth), 9 (industry, innovation and infrastructure), 10 (reduced inequalities), 12 (responsible consumption and production) and 13 (climate action).

- 3. Entrepreneurship in agricultural supply chains
